Good firm start with lots of drive ad
 sense of occasion - before D Fnt SH
 not in tune - some applies at Horn only
 before E - lots of drive to the end - Trump be
 careful of tuning - ad an bridge to II - Nicely done
 concert - Euph strains a bit but settles - so not
 happy a intonation of open notes - progresses well -
 before P a little ungainly P+ so many gaps
 for breath the phrase becomes disjointed S good
 intonation with brass but except for muted notes
 at the end - good bridge to III - lots of life ad
 drive - but middle intonation esp. horns is disappointing -
 - good sense of build though - towards AA problems
 as some players tire ad ensemble becomes a little loose
 ad untuneful - but you have to the finish.

A confident performance that made up for some
 technical deficiencies - musically quite satisfactory
 to. Well done ad thank you.
