Translation

March – Standard of St George

A good tempo that suits the march. Ensemble is light in lower end of full ensemble but everything is in place. Smooth lines with shape & character. Trio could be lighter in dynamics and has some loose moments but was mostly well controlled with a thought out ending.

Points

Test Piece – Triptych

A lively start but I miss tims. Some scrappy entries occasionally but it all fits in well. Dynamics were active but bass line was confused at **F** and solo entries were insecure beyond. Lower tuning problems developed and some lines were overblown. Accel didn't work well and trom tuning into **2** was insecure. Confident soloists played with expression. The sustained line was not always even though. **M** bass wrong entry ! **N** Good sounds if not quite gelled ! Upper levels are not balanced and bass line is rather underpowered. Bass trom is dominant at times ! Troms tuning had some insecurity and the exposed unison was very uncertain. Some tentative moments and entries, and not well balanced to close **3** moves well and settles into a lively tempo. **V** + horns / basses don't link together and some untidy moments in ensemble. **X** good sounds and smooth style. Tuning not secure on upper G flugel/rep at **Y**.

This had sections of real security and good playing but it also had moments of unease in tuning and ensemble.
