Repeated section - we lose sound as we finish. Trio - well done. Fanfare - watch that we are together in cornets and tromps. Recap - sop does very well.

March Placing

Testpiece: Glorifico Aeternum (D. Jones)

What a good piece to choose. The tempo is really quite bright, so the euphs struggle on the semis a little. Sop does well. We do very well on the time change. C - is less successful as we approach D. E - is not clear in the start notes - the bright tempo contributes to this. F - good effort euph. Dolce - this is so much better - we have settled down. G - think ^{about} your balance, and where the melody line is. H - nice solo playing - thank you. I - you handle the change of key well. Most of us stay in that key well. K - the transition is mainly successful. L - Hug does well - try to connect the notes so it flows as a melody. M - takes a while to ~~settled~~ settle - perc. O - some togetherness issues. Q - Again, takes a while to settle. S - this is better! Well done. You have a nice broad sound here.
